Step 1 Gather your documents

Depending on the circumstances, we'll need some documents from you to get started.

Documents we'll need:

- Copy of the death certificate
- Executorship documentation
- A copy of the executor's driver's license or other valid form of ID

We can accept any of the following:

- Driver's license
- U.S. passport or passport card
- Photo or non-photo ID
- Immigration card
- Foreign government-issued passport (must show proof of residence)
- Permanent residence card
- U.S. military or common access card
